I Introduction/ Welcome

- CaryAnn welcomed everyone back to a new qtr after a summer. There are some changes from previous qtrs including a lack of officer held positions.
- II. Officer position/ Openings

- Open spots include: president x 1, VP x 2, brown bag x 1, treasurer x 1, fundraiser committee x 2, and graduation committee x 2.
- Laurel took the brown bag position. Juliane Hanes and Kelly Dempsy to the graduation committee positions
- CaryAnn will send out the roles to let people know what the positions entail.

III Volunteers for pre-req classes

- Christina and Heather will go next Tuesday, will get together to coordinate.
- Anja spoke of benefits and what to talk about to the pre-req classes: study techniques, focus areas, to talk of nsg. To help them “understand why they are learning, and how it is integrated into nsg.
- This role was said to be part of the VP's role. Currently no Vps.

IV The Pulse

- CaryAnn can not do it this qtr. She briefly went over what the editors role would be.
- Doug Harper and Ev Berger volunteered to be co-editors.
- Eunice is still layout editor.

V The Welcome Party

- Scott Dakins gave brief recap of the recent welcome party. “It went fine.”
- Around the room the 'no food' issue was brought up. Said to be “sad,” but Sharon with her positive attitude said it made for an “easier clean-up.”
- Discussion about the food issue tied to the upcoming graduation and the little theater not being available for Fall qtr.

VI Graduation

- Fall qtr graduation will be Dec 10, 1400-1800.
- Anna has reserved the dinning area in the PUB, for approx 200 people. Work request was put in as well for stage and chair set-up.
- “Bad news” is the acoustics in the new space. Aron mentioned renting special drapes. Heather volunteered to look into finding 'piper'?-special acoustic draping.
- Aron's meeting with Chartwells was pushed back to next week. He has list of food and services. Sharon reminded him to make sure they do set-up and clean-up.
- Regarding Chartwells and the expensive food, Sharon said it is a long term contract, no options. She sent e-mails a few times and received back “do you clearly understand.”

- Anja: has programs and names, but not decided on speakers. Regarding theme of graduation, may not do flowers, but go with a winter theme.
- Anna needs to know the number of invitations to get. Must be sent out approx 1 month prior to event.

VII Brown Bags

- CaryAnn and Heather gave brief overview of what a brown bag is. Heather also gave recap of last qtr.
- With the late start and lack of help, there may only be 2 brown bags this qtr, maybe three.
- Takes time to plan. Getting the room can be difficult, 1-1.5 wks to reserve.
- So far two tentative dates in November, 4th and 18th. SCCANS meeting on the 25th.

VIII Outback Fundraiser

- “Anyone interested?”
- Sharon spoke on how our club money has been dwindling, and that there are many restrictions on how it can be used (ie., no food, books, decorations...). She explained how fundraising has been the means to have money for events such as graduation and the welcome party.
- CaryAnn talked about the Outback. “This is the big fund raiser.” That it is fun. Sharon commented on how we have in the past raised \$1500-3000, and last time, \$3600.
- Sharon: Tickets need to be sold during the 4-6wk prior to event, and must know how many are sold to give estimate to Outback 2wks ahead of time.
- We can not do it this Fall. Looking at winter, end of Feb, tentative date for the 28th.
- Laurel Coe and Salley Hallen will be Outback coordinators. Anja will send forms and contact info for Jennifer.

IX Job Fair interjection

- Anja: “What about job fair.” Talked about what the job fair was. There were problem previously with parking and location.
- School said to have a job fair as well. We can give them a list and the school will contact and organize.

X SCCANS Website

- Sharon let us know the decision to choose a family was by the faculty after names were submitted.
- Eunice and Christina will work on it, Teresa Wilson and Laurel Coe offered to help.
- Reps will be encouraged explain project and to pass change jar every week.
