Budget Update:

Sandie and Nick have submitted the supplemental budget request to Student Government in the amount of \$4600 for the year. There is a Student Government meeting scheduled for 2:30 on Nov. 29th to determine supplemental budget requests for campus clubs. We receive a baseline of \$1000 and must request more as we need it for graduation, CE funds, etc. We need to encourage more fundraising as graduation eats up a large chunk of

our funds every quarter. Sandie also brought to our attention the request from the United Club Counsel that all events for our program be posted on “Day-at-a-Glance”, which will increase visibility of Nursing program functions. This is a mandatory responsibility and is currently handled by Sunshine as part of the web manager’s job.

Graduation:

Jill is in need of volunteers for graduation responsibilities. A sign-up sheet was passed around, more volunteers are needed and the representatives should let their quarters know. The final program will be out by the end of this week and must be proofread. Generally graduation is hosted by 5th quarter, but involvement from all quarters is encouraged.

Welcome Breakfast:

Tabitha has offered to coordinate if no one else steps up. There have been a few 1st quarter students who would like to help by making bags, etc. but no real leader as of yet. The breakfast is Wednesday, January 18th at 7:15 in room 2346. Dianna and Sharon will be assisting by giving information, pointers, etc. Budget is \$100 for food and \$75 for bags.
